This plan pays substantial benefits for a stay in the Intensive Care unit and covers Sub-Acute ICU. Also covered is a benefit if a Major Organ Transplant is needed. The daily benefit grows monthly until age 65. Benefits are reduced at age 70. No lifetime maximum.
